Calibre Audio Library is fully committed to respecting the privacy of all personal information received through this website. Whether you contact us to register as a member, for new publications or to order catalogues we will only use your personal information to deliver the services you have requested.

All the information we have about members and supporters is controlled by the Data Protection Act 1998. We are only allowed to keep the information we need to supply our service, and for our financial records. It is all kept securely and access to it is strictly controlled.

Types of Information we Collect

We collect quantitative data through general Web logs but this contains only aggregate information on the pages accessed by visitors. Individual data is captured by Web forms, for instance when registering for information or when ordering publications, for the purpose of fulfilling orders and requests for information.

We do not share personal information with third parties without consent and users may request not to receive emails at any time by contacting us. When members leave Calibre we destroy the information about use of the library, and keep other information only as long as necessary for accounting and audit purposes.
