Thank you for your interest in Calibre's group membership scheme. With this letter we are sending you an application form, so that you can join if you would like to try it.

Calibre Audio Library brings the pleasure of reading to people who have sight problems or physical disabilities through a free, nationwide postal service of recorded books. Our group membership scheme costs £50 a year and enables hospitals, care homes, schools and other organisations with several print disabled clients to borrow up to eight books at a time. It is also possible for people to join as individuals - in that case please ask us for a copy of the individual membership form.

We offer a choice of over 7,500 titles on standard cassette, as well as an increasing range on MP3 disk. The books are sent and returned by post, free of charge, under the 'Articles for the Blind' system.

If you like, we can choose books for your clients, based on their age and the sorts of books you think they will enjoy. Alternatively you can send us a list of titles, and we will then send you books from this list whenever possible. In that case you will need to request one or more of our catalogues, or use the Calibre website.

If you would like to join, please complete the form overleaf and return it with your cheque/credit card payment for £50. When we receive your application we will send your first selection of books, and information explaining how to use the service.

We hope you will find the service useful. If you have any questions or problems do please let us know.
