Calibre Audio Library is fully committed to respecting the privacy of all personal information received through this website. Whether you contact us to register as a member, to receive new publications; or to order catalogues, merchandising or make a donation, we will only use your personal information to deliver the services you have requested. We will only use this information to inform you about Calibre and services in which you may be interested. If we are required to make any changes to the way we use your personal information we will ask for your consent before we do so.

All the information we have about members and supporters is controlled by the Data Protection Act 1998. We are only allowed to keep the information we need to supply our service, and for our financial records. It is all kept securely and access to it is strictly controlled.

Information we collect

We collect quantitative data through general web logs, but this contains only aggregate information on the pages accessed by visitors. Individual data is captured by web forms, for instance when registering for information, when ordering publications; or as a member, updating your book request list, for the purpose of fulfilling orders and requests for information.

We do not share or sell personal information for any purpose with third parties without consent. Users may request not to receive emails at any time by contacting us. When members leave Calibre we destroy the

information about their use of the library, and keep other information only as long as necessary for accounting and audit purposes.
